- 6 New coil
- 7 New plug wires (made specific for the TO-30) and plugs
- 8 New battery and starter cables including long cable for proper grounding. All correct/larger size for 6 volt system
- 9 New wire harness made specifically for the Ferguson TO-30
- 10 New fan belt
- 11 Radiator replaced with good original used Ferguson radiator
- 12 New radiator cap and drain petcock.
- 13 New upper and lower radiator hoses
- 14 New battery
- 15 New key switch
- 16 Determined that original Ferguson Oil and amp gages worked good. Better quality than most aftermarket guages
- 17 New shifter boot and knob
- 18 Carburetor overhauled with new kit
- 19 Gas tank chemically cleaned and sealed eliminating rust problems
- 20 New sediment bowl
- ${\bf 21}\,$  New engine oil and filter. Cleaned oil bath air cleaner and filled with oil
- 22 New transmission oil
- 23 New clutch plate
- 25 Steering box sealed with new gasket and filled to proper level with oil

- 5 Sprayed PPG epoxy primer to all surfaces.
- $\,$  6 Sprayed 2 coats custom tinted Acrylic modified Alkyd enamel with hardener.
- Hardener makes the paint resistant to oil and gas.
- Color is Ferguson Gray and original for the TO-30
- 7 Rear rims painted silver as original
- 8 Starter, generator, distributor painted black as original
- 9 Refurbished original Ferguson name plate badges. "Ferguson" on Hood front and "Ferguson-30" on hood sides. Painted blue background with gray lettering as original.
